The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) has announced recalls of the following products. Consumers should stop using recalled products unless otherwise instructed.

Baby long johns

Units: About 5,500

Distributor: Personal Creations, of Lemont, Ill.

Hazard: The metal snaps can loosen and detach, posing a choking hazard to young children.

Description: The long johns are red with snap fasteners down the front and along the legs. A personalized embroidery is stitched across the button-up back flap. The long johns were sold in sizes 6, 12, 18 and 24 months.

Sold through: Personal Creations catalog and www.personalcreations.com from September 2006 through January 2007 for about \$22.
