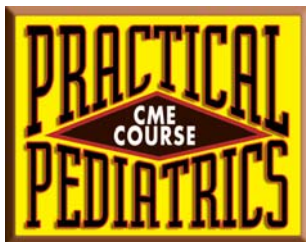
### Warm up in Amelia Island, Fla., with Practical Pediatrics
