**Units:** About 610,000

**Importer:** Target, of Minneapolis

**Hazard:** The flashlights can overheat and melt, posing a burn hazard to consumers.

**Description:** This recall involves Halloween-themed mini flashlights and flashlights sold with stencils.

**Sold exclusively at:** Target stores nationwide from August through September 2009 for \$1 for the mini flashlights and \$2.50 for the flashlights with stencils.

**Remedy:** Return the product to any Target store for a refund.
