### Cribs

**Units:** About 535,000

**Importer:** Stork Craft Manufacturing Inc.,  
of British Columbia, Canada

**Hazard:** The metal brackets used to support the mattress board can break, causing the mattress to collapse and creating a gap in which a child can become entrapped and suffocate.



**Description:** All cribs with manufacturing and distribution dates between May 2000 and November 2008 are recalled.

**Sold at:** Major retailers, including JCPenney, Kmart and Wal-Mart stores nationwide, and online at Amazon.com, Babiesrus.com, Costco.com and Walmart.com from May 2000 through January 2009 for \$100 to \$400.
