Portable play yards

Units: About 200,000

Importer: Simplicity Inc. and SFCA Inc., of Reading, Pa.

Hazard: One or more rails can collapse, posing a fall or entrapment hazard to children.

Description: The portable play yards were sold with a bassinet, changing table and mobile. The products have a rain forest-patterned fabric and the Fisher-Price logo. Simplicity model numbers are 5310 RNF, 5310RNFC and 5310RNFV.



Sold at: Retailers and specialty children's stores nationwide from January 2007 through January 2009 for about \$100.

Remedy: Although it did not manufacture or sell the play yards, Fisher-Price has agreed to assist consumers.
