HEALTH ALERTS

The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) has announced recalls of the following products. Consumers should stop using recalled products unless otherwise instructed. For a complete list of recalled products, visit www.cpsc.gov.

Rattles

Units: About 131,000 (in addition to 20,000 recalled in March 2008)

Importer: Infantino LLC, of San Diego

Hazard: The tail piece on the rattles can detach, posing a choking hazard.

Description: The recalled rattles are shaped like a lamb or a lion. Each has a ring-shaped body. The production code is printed behind the ear in a dial format with the year (08) in the middle of a circle and an arrow pointing to the number on the circle (01 or 05) that indicates the month.

Sold at: Wal-Mart, Babies "R" Us and other specialty stores nationwide from May 2007 through September 2008 for \$3 to \$4.

Remedy: Contact Infantino for a replacement rattle or a product of equal value.
