Lip gloss key chains

Units: About 75,000

Importer: Markwins Beauty Products, of City of Industry, Calif.

Hazard: The key chain's metal clasp contains high levels of lead, which is toxic if ingested by young children.

Description: "Lip Gloss," "Brillant á lèvres," "Fantasy Makers" and "from the creators of Wet n Wild" are printed on the lip gloss tubes.

Sold at: Rite Aid, Kmart, Fred Meyer and Wal-Mart stores nationwide during October 2008 for about \$1.
