**Units:** About 7,300

**Importer:** Wilton Industries Inc. of Woodridge, Ill.

**Hazard:** The tiara contains high levels of lead, which is toxic if ingested by young children.

**Description:** The Wilton Youth Tiara is silver-colored with clear crystals.

**Sold at:** Party City, Jo-Ann Fabrics, Ben Franklin Stores, Amazon.com and other retailers nationwide from June 2009 through April 2010 for about \$13.
