The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) has announced the recall of the following products. Consumers should stop using recalled products unless otherwise instructed. Consumers can submit reports of harm to CPSC's new searchable online product safety database at www.SaferProducts.gov. Children's sleepwear

Units: About 4,000

Importer: Fashionviews Inc., of New Rochelle, N.Y.

Hazard: The garments fail to meet federal flammability standards for children's sleepwear, posing a risk of burn injury to children.

Description: All styles of P.Jamas brand name children's sleepwear sold in children's sizes XS through XL are recalled. Sleepwear sets are 100% cotton woven or knit fabric and come in a variety of pastel colors in solid, stripe or plaid patterns.

Sold at: Boutique shops nationwide and www.p-jamas.com from January 2006 through October 2010 for \$50 to \$100.

Remedy: Return to retailer where purchased for a refund.
