Importer: Horizon Hobby Inc., of Champaign, Ill.

Hazard: The main blade grips and main rotor blades can release from the main rotor head and hit or cut a person.

Description: Blade ultra-micro indoor/outdoor helicopters have red and blue canopies with the name "Blade mCP X" printed on both sides. Recalled are: Bind-N-Fly Helicopter (BLH3580), Ready to Fly Helicopter (BLH3500), main blade grips with bearings replacement part (BLH3514).

Sold by: Retailers nationwide for \$180 to \$220 for the model helicopters and \$10 for the replacement part.
