Labor Day weekend getaway offers CME in the Windy City

Looking for a getaway destination that offers a rich cultural experience and plenty to see and do on a lakefront backdrop? Escape to Chicago for the Practical Pediatrics continuing medical education session Sept. 2-4 at the Renaissance Chicago Downtown Hotel.
