Units: About 2,000

Manufacturers: GAMMA Sports, of Pittsburgh, Pa.

Hazard: The orange grip tape on the tennis racket's handle contains high levels of lead, which is toxic if ingested by children.

Description: Quick Kids 23-inch aluminum junior tennis racquets have lot number F:3:10:08 stamped onto the bottom.

Sold: Online at gammاسports.com, atssports.com and holabirdsports.com from December 2010 through March 2011 for about \$15.
