Wooden animal drum

Units: About 1,000

Importer: Cost Plus Inc., of Oakland, Calif.

Hazard: The paint used on the drum has high levels of lead, which is toxic if ingested by children.

Description: The wooden hexagon drum has pictures of animals on the six sides.

Sold at: Cost Plus World Market stores nationwide from December 2010 through May 2011 for about \$7.

Remedy: Return to store for a refund.
