Units: About 375,000

Importer: Target Corp., of Minneapolis

Hazard: The booster seat's restraint buckle can open unexpectedly.

Description: The Circo brand plastic booster seats can be attached to an adult chair. They are blue with green trim and a white plastic restraint buckle.



Sold by: Target stores from January 2005 to June 2009 for about \$13.

Remedy: Stop using the seats and return them to any Target for a refund.
