Hazard: The plastic flowers can detach, posing a choking hazard.

Description: The Circo infant girls' sandals are white with decorative plastic flowers attached to the toes and sides. They were sold under the name "Aloma" in infant girls' sizes 2 through 5.

Sold at: Target and Target.com from January to May 2011 for about \$10.

Remedy: Return to store for refund.
