The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) has announced the recall of the following products. Consumers should stop using recalled products unless otherwise instructed. ### Baby seats

**Units:** About 4 million

**Manufacturer:** Bumbo International Trust, of South Africa

**Hazard:** Babies can maneuver out of or fall from the Bumbo seat, posing a risk of serious injuries.

**Description:** The Bumbo seat is constructed of a single piece of molded foam and comes in various colors. The seat has leg holes, and the seat back wraps completely around the child.

**Sold by:** Sears, Target, Toys R Us, Babies R Us, USA Babies, Walmart and various other toy and children's stores nationwide, and various online sellers, from August 2003 through August 2012 for \$30 to \$50.

**Remedy:** Stop using the product until installing a free repair kit, which includes a restraint belt. Even with the belt, the seat should never be used on a raised surface. Consumers also should stop using Bumbo seat covers that interfere with the installation and use of the belt.
