## In Memoriam

### Nebraska Medical Association president, Dr. Bosley

Warren Bosley, M.D., FAAP, of Lincoln, Neb., died Oct. 18 at age 90. President of the Nebraska Medical Association (1975-'76), he was former chair of the AAP Council on Pediatric Practice, Committee on

Third Party Programs (Child Health Financing), Chapter Chairmen's Committee, and Task Forces on Preventive Child Health Care and Medical Liability.

In 1985, Dr. Bosley ran for AAP president and conceded to William C. Montgomery, M.D., FAAP.

As Nebraska Medical Association president, he led a successful battle for medical liability legislation reform. He also served as an examiner for the American Board of Pediatrics and on Nebraska's Board of Health, Commission for Children and Youth, and Special Education Appeals.

In his hometown, he was a member of the Grand Island School Board from 1959-1993 and team doctor for senior high athletics.

He is survived by his wife, five sons, a daughter, 10 grandchildren and 16 great grandchildren.
