The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) has announced the recall of the following products. Consumers should stop using recalled products unless otherwise instructed. ### Infant water shoes

**Units:** About 34,000 in the United States and 3,800 in Canada

**Importer:** Old Navy, of San Francisco

**Hazard:** The water shoes have less traction when worn on wet or smooth surfaces, such as hardwood or tile, creating a slip and fall hazard.

**Description:** The slip-on shoes have pull-on tabs on both the front and back of the foot opening of the shoe. These Aqua Socks were sold in pink and purple in toddler sizes 5-11 with style number 896452.

**Sold at:** Old Navy stores, at [oldnavy.com](http://oldnavy.com) and at [oldnavy.ca](http://oldnavy.ca) from February through June 2012 for \$12 to \$15.

**Remedy:** Return shoes to any Old Navy store for a refund. Consumers who return the shoes before Nov. 9 will receive a coupon for \$10 off their next purchase at Old Navy.
