Hazard: The stuffed animal's eye can detach, and young children can choke on it.

Description: The Build-A-Bear stuffed monster "Sulley" is covered in blue furry fabric with purple spots. It has a horn on its head and blue eyes. A tracking label ending with 4384 or 4385 for USA and 4378 for Canada can be found on a sewn-in label on the backside of the monster's leg.
