**Hazard:** The opening between the grab bar and seat bottom of the stroller can allow an infant to become trapped at the neck, posing a strangulation hazard.

**Description:** Recalled are EVO strollers manufactured between February 2012 (date code: 01.02.12) and November 2012 (30.11.12) with the following model numbers: MT12-03, MT12-11, MT12-14, MT12-31, MT12-34, MT12-37, MT12-39, MT12-42, MT12-43 and MT12-48. The model number and date code can be found underneath the stroller seat. The strollers have black or silver metal frames with brown, navy blue, black or white seats. "EVO" is printed on the lower back frame of the stroller.
