### BMX helmets

**Units:** About 2,500

**Hazard:** The buckle on the helmet's safety strap can release in an accident and allow the helmet to fall off the rider.

**Description:** Recalled are Bell Full Throttle, full coverage bicycle motocross (BMX) helmets with a chin bar. The all-black helmets have UPC code 035011 937052 and part number 1009159 printed on a label on the side of the helmet shell.
