### Girls' clothing sets

**Units:** 9,200

**Hazard:** The vest sold with these sets has a belt that could become snagged or caught in small spaces or vehicle doors, posing an entanglement hazard.

**Description:** Young Hearts brand three-piece clothing sets were sold with a pink vest, black pullover shirt and knit pants in sizes 12 months to 6X. Young Hearts is printed on a label inside the shirt collar. The pink vest has a black bow applique and a pink elastic belt with silver clasps.

**Sold at:** Conway, Citi Trends, Duckwall-Alco and other children's apparel stores nationwide and online at [Amazon.com](http://Amazon.com) from September through December 2012 for about \$40.

**Remedy:** Remove the belt from the vest, or return the sets to the store where purchased for a refund.
