The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) has announced the recall of the following products. Consumers should stop using recalled products unless otherwise instructed. Children's pajamas

Units: About 710

Hazard: The pajamas can catch on fire easily, posing a risk of burn injuries to children.

Description: This recall involves Vive La Fete children's cotton or cotton/polyester two-piece pajama sets. They were sold in children's sizes 6 months through size 12 and consist of a long-sleeve shirt with collar and buttons paired with matching full-length pants with elastic waistband. Pajamas come in blue with a white snowflake pattern or red and white gingham checkered pattern.
