The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) has announced the recall of the following products. Consumers should stop using recalled products unless otherwise instructed. Consumers can submit reports of harm to CPSC's new searchable online product safety database at www.SaferProducts.gov. A searchable food and medical product recall database is available at www.fda.gov/Safety/Recalls/default.htm.

Fragrance diffusers

Units: About 2,100

Hazard: The label on the diffusers does not list the presence of petroleum distillates, which can cause breathing problems if swallowed.

Description: The recall includes Paddywax diffusers sold in three fragrances: ECO blood orange with bergamot, ECO grapefruit with coriander and RELISH ocean tide with sea salt. The diffusers were sold in a tan cylinder-shaped container. The diffuser includes a green or blue glass vase and evaporating diffuser sticks. Paddywax and the fragrance name are printed on the front of the cylinder.

Sold at: Small gift shops, grocery, pharmacy, plant nurseries and spas nationwide and at www.Paddywax.com from January through April 2013 for about \$28.
