The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) has announced the recall of the following products. Consumers should stop using recalled products unless otherwise instructed. Baby jumpers

Units: About 400,000

Hazard: The sun toy on the activity jumper can bounce back and hurt the baby.

Description: Baby Einstein Musical Motion Activity Jumpers with model number 90564 (found on a tag under the blue fabric seat) have three activity centers and brightly colored toys around the seat. The yellow sun toy is attached to the seat frame on a flexible stalk with three or five colored rings. Jumpers with codes indicating a manufacture date before November 2011 are recalled: OD0, OE0, OF0, OG0, OH0, OI0, OJ0, OK0, OL0, OA1, OB1, OC1, OD1, OE1, OF1, OG1, OH1, OI1, OJ1 and OK1. The date code is on a label on the back of the seat pad.

Sold at: Target, Toys R Us and other retail stores and at Amazon.com between May 2010 and May 2013 for about \$90.
