**Hazard:** Wipes may be infected with a type of bacteria that can cause infections in people with weak immune systems or chronic lung diseases.

**Description:** The white, pre-moistened baby wipes were sold under the brand names Cuties, Diapers.com, Femtex, Fred's, Kidgets, Member's Mark, Simply Right, Sunny Smiles, Tender Touch and Well Beginnings.

**Sold at:** Walgreens, Sam's Club, Family Dollar, Fred's and Diapers.com

**Remedy:** Return the wipes to the place of purchase for a refund.
