Hazard: Pieces of the whistle can detach and pose a choking hazard.

Description: Whistle has a red mouthpiece that attaches to a plastic Hello Kitty figure with a pink lollipop.

Sold at: Distributed from October to November 2014, with Happy Meals and Mighty Kids Meals at McDonald's restaurants.

Remedy: Return whistles to McDonald's for a replacement toy.
