### Home playground tube slides

**Units:** About 10,800

**Hazard:** The plastic windows in the tube slide can break and cut children.

**Description:** Solowave Tornado brand home playground tube slides with port holes are green, 6 or 7 feet long, and have three or five port hole-style plastic windows in the sides. The slides were sold with Solowave's Centennial, Centennial II, Lexington, Rocky Mountain Deluxe and Sheridan play systems or were sold separately.

**Sold at:** Toys R Us and other stores nationwide, and at [toysrus.com](http://toysrus.com) from February 2008 through August 2013 for \$1,300 to \$1,800 as part of a play system, or \$275 to \$370 for just the slide.
