Hazard: The jackets have a band of material at the neck that can strangle young children.

Description: The girls' jackets have the name U.S. Polo Assn. with the year 1890, crossed polo mallets, a silhouette of two polo players and the initials USPA. The jackets come in fuchsia, green and cream in girls' sizes 4-16. Q4 Designs LLC and style numbers can be found on the white label tag sewn into the inside of the jacket near the waist band. Recalled style numbers include U274-200 for sizes 4-6 and U274-300 for sizes 7-16.

Sold at: Burlington Coat Factory, Kids Stop and Cookie's Department Stores from August to October 2013 for about \$15.
