Bed canopies

Units: About 255,000

Hazard: An infant or young child can be strangled by the canopy's fabric.

Description: Children's bed canopies are made from mesh fabric and hang from the ceiling onto a child's crib or bed. The canopy's name is printed on the washing instructions label. Recalled are: BARNSLIG Boll (201.078.30); FABLER (201.308.78); HIMMEL-Blue (901.376.40); HIMMEL-Blue/White (201.758.38); HIMMEL-Green (701.376.41); HIMMEL-Pink (101.376.39); KLÄMMIG (928.165.95); LEGENDARISK (600.506.81); MINNEN Bed Canopy Set (900.877.58); MINNEN Brodyr (501.076.78); and TISSLA (902.367.15).
