Units: About 174,000

Hazard: The circuit board in the chest of the doll can overheat, causing the doll to get hot and burn children.

Description: The My Sweet Love/My Sweet Baby electronic baby doll has pink floral clothing and matching knit hat. The 16-inch doll comes with a toy medical check-up kit, including a stethoscope, feeding spoon, thermometer and syringe. The doll's electronics cause her to babble when she gets "sick," her cheeks turn red and she starts coughing. UPC 6-04576-16800-5 and a date code that begins with WM are printed on the label sewn into the bottom of the doll.

Sold exclusively at: Walmart stores nationwide from August 2012 through March 2014 for \$20.
