The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) has announced the recall of the following products. Consumers should stop using recalled products unless otherwise instructed. Consumers can submit reports of harm to CPSC's new searchable online product safety database at www.SaferProducts.gov. Bunny toys, bear rattles

Units: About 98,000

Hazard: The pom-pom tail can come off, and children can choke on it.

Description: Recalled Vera Bradley bear ring rattles and bunny stuffed animal toys are made of cotton and fleece. The rattle has a white teddy bear head, arms attached to an O-shaped body with a green, blue, brown and pink crisscross pattern design rattle. The bunny was sold in three printed patterns. All items have a white pom-pom tail.
