The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) has announced the recall of the following products. Consumers should stop using recalled products unless otherwise instructed. Consumers can submit reports of harm to CPSC's new searchable online product safety database at www.SaferProducts.gov. Units: About 1,400

Hazard: The pajamas can catch on fire easily.

Description: Empress Arts 100% cotton children's two-piece pajama sets were sold in boys' and girls' sizes 12 months to toddler size 4 in four styles: blue dot, blue stripe, pink dot and pink floral. "Empress Arts" is on a label at the back of the neck of the tops and the center back of the waist on the bottoms, which have an elastic waistband and drawstring.
