The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) has announced the recall of the following products. Consumers should stop using recalled products unless otherwise instructed. Consumers can submit reports of harm to CPSC's searchable online product safety database at www.SaferProducts.gov. A searchable food and medical product recall database is available at www.fda.gov/Safety/Recalls/default.htm.

Pajamas

Units: About 7,000

Hazard: The pajamas may catch on fire easily, posing a risk of burn injuries to children.

Description: This recall involves Star Ride Kids girl's pajama sets. The recalled pajamas are made of polyester and were sold in sizes 4 through 14. The pajama sets consist of polar fleece pants with a bow and elastic at the waist and a jersey two-piece long-sleeve shirt. Style reference number 5217 or 5250 is on the label. "Star Ride Taking It To The Next Level" is on a label in the waistband of pants.

Sold at: Children's boutiques and department stores nationwide from August through November 2013 for \$10 to \$13.

Remedy: Return pajamas to the place of purchase for a refund.
