### Snowboard bindings

**Units:** About 10,400

**Hazard:** A pin can come loose and cause the binding to open, posing a fall hazard.

**Description:** The Flow 2014 Flite-series snowboard bindings have model names Flite, Haylo, Micron Youth, Flite LTD and Flite MTN. The bindings have a snap lock lever on the rear and a cable adjustment dial on the side of the baseplate. Colors include black; black and white; black, white and blue; or black, white, blue and yellow.
