Atlanta course offers intensive CME relevant to clinical practice

"Developmental and Behavioral Pediatrics," with Jessica L. Roesser, M.D., FAAP, is among course highlights. Attendees will learn how to recognize differences in screening tests, explain the differences in types of delays, understand the range of ability in children with intellectual disabilities, translate educational testing into educational recommendations and identify children at risk for autism spectrum disorders.

"Adolescent Health," with Monica Sifuentes, M.D., also includes sought-after information. Session attendees will learn to identify typical pubertal development in boys and girls; understand hormonal changes that occur during puberty; review and interpret the appropriate clinical data and laboratory studies for the evaluation of an adolescent during the growth spurt; differentiate typical from atypical pubertal development in males and females; understand the association between cognitive, emotional, social and physical development during adolescence; recognize the role and impact of family, environment and society on adolescent psychological development; and differentiate among common experimentation, high-risk and maladaptive behavior during adolescence.
